

## Adult Gym Equipment Responses Received

1. In response to your question about installing adult gym on the periphery of the Field [REDACTED] and I are strongly in favour and would use it.  
Following up from my previous email supporting outdoor equipment on Court Meadow  
I have walked around looking for the best location.  
If it were to be placed by the skate park where there is an free area would it be a distraction for the footballers? It would certainly be possible to place it all together there.  
Otherwise on the rougher environmental side of the footpath going up from the Rose and Crown. It could be placed either all together (avoiding blocking the view from the seat half way down) or dotted along that perimeter.  
I have just one request! That it is not placed on the mown playing field area but only on the periphery outside the circular path.
2. I would happily support the idea to put adult sports equipment on Court Meadow- the space certainly gets used by people taking outdoor exercise. Also don't forget improvements to the bike ramps and dirt bike track on Court Meadow which we have been discussing for some time now. I think that we provide very little for the active young in the village, particularly the secondary age children and young people. They need some sort of outlet for their energy and many of them do not have access to fields and green spaces to mess about in.  
Please could you share my support with the rest of the Parish Council members.

  - 1) Could bring noise nuisance and anti social behaviour closer to residents
  - 2) It's good to keep a strip of land that is not so manicured for wildlife
  - 3) Keeping the grass longer here helps to prevent water running off to the properties below.

I believe it will be used by parents dropping their children off at the primary school and teenagers as well as those of retirement age who want to keep fit like my husband and myself but don't like gyms with loud music not of our choice.
